The First la France Insoumise for French citizens abroad Summer School

From June 6th to 8th, 2025, the first edition of "Insoumis•es Sans Frontières" (Unbowed Without Borders) will be held in Berlin: a summer school dedicated to French citizens living abroad, left-wing activists and supporters, featuring three days of conferences, workshops, and training sessions on current political issues.

A Political Event to Discuss the Future of Insoumis•es Abroad

Organized by various la France Insoumise abroad action groups, the "Insoumis•es Sans Frontières" event will provide an opportunity to gather together, reflect together, and educate each other on current political and societal challenges. Berlin, a multicultural and creative city, proved to be the ideal location to host this first edition. The German capital garnered over 70% of the votes for Asma Rharmoui-Claquin, the LFI-NFP candidate in the last legislative elections, and has hundreds of activists on site.

The agenda includes conferences and debates on current political topics, such as our panel on the necessity of a left breaking away from social democracy and another on the importance of international solidarity in our struggles. We will hold several conferences on key points of our demand for greater social justice: feminist and LGBTQI struggles, ecology, access to water, anti-racism, and anti-imperialism. The fight against the far right, nowadays more essential than ever, will also be the subject of a conference during the event.

Several workshops and training sessions are also planned, including training on activist argumentation and another on electoral campaign preparation. For those unable to travel, several conferences will be broadcast live online. And finally, as this event also aims to be a convivial and festive moment, we will enjoy a great cultural program with DJ sets, queer quizzes, and a film-debate.

Many political figures from la France Insoumise will be present, such as Hadrien Clouet, Nadège Abomangoli, Rachel Kéké, Emma Fourreau, as well as figures from the New Popular Front like Sandrine Rousseau and Camille Hachez. University researchers will also contribute, including Mickael Idrac, professor of sociology of education and migration sociology. Finally, we will have the pleasure of welcoming engaged content creators who will share their views on the role of social networks in social struggles.
